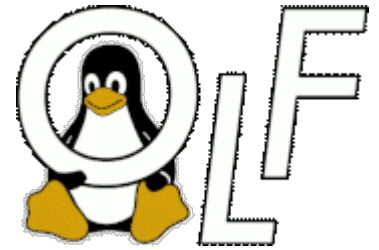


OLF Conference 2023 Schedule
